## REVIEW THE EXAMPLE REPORT AND USE THAT AS YOUR MODEL!

You will research one Native American Group. The information for the project will come from your books, the encyclopedia or the internet and each source must be noted on the bibliography page. You will need to use at least **three sources**. The finished product should be a colorful, neatly done project with correct spelling and punctuation. There will be two grades given: one in social studies, and one in writing. Below is a summary of the pages in the report.

- Cover: Include the name of your group and your name. It should be decorated with objects/the art style from the Native American group you studied
- Page 1: US map with group's region colored in and a dot where the group lived (no dot if your group was nomadic)
- Page 2: Geography/Climate/Natural Resources: Explain what the land looked like, what the weather was like there during the year, and what natural resources were available to them.
- Page 3: Homes: Explain what kind of homes they built (what they looked like, their features, what materials they used).
- Page 4: Daily Life: Explain what they wore, what they ate and different roles for men and women.
- Page 5 Illustration page: Draw a picture of the home, and a Native American man and woman from the group. Draw a background behind the home to show the type of area where they lived.
- Page 6: Celebrations/Ceremonies/Religion: Explain one of these topics in detail.
- Page 7: Interesting Facts: This is the place to list any additional information that was interesting to you. Include things like the kinds of art they made, unique customs and more.
- Page 8: Bibliography (at least 3 resources)

**Extra Credit:** You may build a small-scale, authentic dwelling for your Native American group. Be sure the base of the dwelling is no bigger than a piece of paper. Build it on a cardboard or cardstock base and make it look as realistic as possible. Due: \_\_\_\_\_
